

**New documentary *Private Violence*, featuring A CALL TO MEN screens as a Work in Progress at Full Frame Documentary Film Festival.**



***Private Violence*** is a new documentary film that explores the complex issue of domestic violence in America and examines the social movement that has pushed back against this crime for decades. With the support and participation of such luminaries as Vice President Joe Biden, and feminist icons Gloria Steinem and Ann Jones, *Private Violence* presents an authentic chronicle of the history of the Battered Women’s Movement, its successes and failures and what still needs to be done today to end violence against women and children. All over the country, community groups, non-profits and schools are instituting cutting edge programs that confront traditional views of masculinity and violence. ***Private Violence*** features commentary by both Ted and Tony on the issue of domestic violence, and presents A Call to Men in action as they engage a group of college students at Columbia University in NY in a conversation about men’s socialization and as they talk with 12 year olds on a basketball team about respecting women, and what it means to be a man. *Private Violence* recently screened as a work in progress at the esteemed Full Frame Documentary Film Festival in Durham, North Carolina and received a very positive response.
